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Year 1 Walking Excursion to Mawson Ponds Friday 6 December 2024 9.30am-11:00 am

Dear Parents and Carers,

Students in Year 1 have been learning about the natural, managed and constructed features of places. They observe, identify and describe these features within their school and at a local level. They recount Dreamtime Stories of the Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Peoples and identify the natural features. Students describe the features of a local park and investigate how parks are cared for. To culminate the learning, teachers would like to facilitate a local walking excursion to the Mawson Pond and local area.

During the walk, students will be encouraged to identify places they know and have visited and discuss why they are special/ important to the community.

We are hoping to engage a volunteer to communicate the significance of the pond and the local flora and fauna.

Parent volunteers are welcomed, and we would appreciate any additional support on the day as students will be required to cross the road. Students will have the opportunity to have fruit break at the pond upon arrival.

These excursions are classified as optional enrichment programs. If you do not wish your child to attend then a program will be available at the school.

Parents who wish their child to attend can pay the full amount within the given timeframe, or alternatively, make arrangements to make regular payments through an agreed payment plan. Cases of hardship should be referred to the Principal for confidential assessment.
