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Preschool Botanic Gardens Excursion Wednesday Week 4 (6th Nov) Yellow Wednesday Week 5 (13th Nov) Red and Blue

Preschool children have been learning about seasons and related changes in our environment. This excursion will expose the children to different types of flora that can be found in the Australian environment during the Spring season. This excursion will also spark curiosity about habitats of Australian animals as we begin our learning about the life cycles of animals in Term 4.

The children would like to have a teddy-bears' picnic at the Botanic Gardens. Students are required to bring their sunhats, drink bottles, fruit and teddies in their back packs- leaving lunch and snack at school for their return. We will travel by bus to the Botanic Gardens to explore the teacher led Eucalypt Discovery Walk (1.8 km approximately 1 hour walking time) to explore Australia's iconic eucalypts and find out about their importance to the environment, to wildlife and to people.



An overview of the day:

- The bus will take us from Mawson Preschool at 9.15am SHARP.
- We will arrive at the gardens at 9.35am.
- 10am take the Eucalypt Walk around gardens through rainforest.
- 10.30am Arrive Burbidge Amphitheatre for fruit break teddy bear picnic.
- 10.15am Continue Eucalypt Walk.
- 11.15am arrive back at bus stop to come back to Preschool.
- 11.45 arrive at Preschool.
- 12pm Lunch at Preschool
- Day continues with regular Wednesday schedule upon arrival at preschool.

We do require parent volunteers to accompany us on the bus and at the Botanic Gardens, please indicate your availability on the permission note (attached). You are also welcome to meet us at the Gardens with younger siblings on your nominated group day.



We will monitor the weather in the lead up to the event. Please dress your children in appropriate clothing for the day. If it is colder, a jacket or jumper that can be put in bags is advisable. If it is very warm, we will take sunscreen that can be re-applied throughout the morning. In the event of light rain, please send a rain jacket and gumboots/sturdy footwear.

In the event of extreme weather, we will cancel the event and will notify families via a DOJO post.

Staff accompanying students on excursions will take all reasonable care while the students are in their charge to protect them from injury and to control and supervise their behaviour and activities.

Parents should be aware that staff members are not responsible for injuries or damage to property, which may occur on an excursion where, in all circumstances, staff have not been negligent. Parents should warn children of the risk to themselves, to others and to property, of impulsive, wilful or disobedient behaviour.

Attendance at this excursion is optional. Schools may offer or facilitate specific optional items, activities and services for which parents are required to pay if they want their child to access them. These excursions are classified as optional enrichment programs. If you do not wish your child to attend then a program will be available at the school.

Parents who wish their child to attend can pay the full amount within the given timeframe, or alternatively, make arrangements to make regular payments through an agreed payment plan. Cases of hardship should be referred to the Principal for confidential assessment.
